I will then finish the session by showing the setup and running of several attendance reports, while providing examples of the best use of these reports in their daily work with attendance.

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Did You Know About Browse Screens?	STUDENT QMLATIV CURRENT USERS	As you work in Qmlativ Browse Screens, you should be aware of various buttons and icons you can click to display additional screens or options. These features help you navigate through your task and enable you to work more intuitively. You can display a detail panel to access a record on a list for viewing or changing information. You can view an expanded screen when you open a record to view or change information. Additionally, you can click More Options to access actions you can perform that affect an entire record, such as deleting it. You can export data and reorder records on a browse screen if needed, as well as update and attach columns to browses. If you wish to view certain information within a column, you can attach a filter to sort information by specific criteria. Alternatively, if you would rather limit the information that is seen within columns, you can choose to update the filters and views created for your browse screens.
